Pray

Turn to God and use the previous question as a springboard for prayer. What might God want to say to you about this? Listen carefully.

In our world many are still lost and in need of the message of Jesus. Talk to God about that. Notice what he is saying to you and what step of faith he is asking you to take.

As you soak this scripture, what do you want to praise God for (who he is) and thank God for (what he's done)? Go ahead and do that.

Live It Out

Invitation/Challenge: This week start by asking God to give you a heart like Paul's—a heart that truly cares for those who don't yet know Jesus. Then, look at your daily routines—your workplace, your neighborhood, your relationships—as your mission field. Begin with small steps: Reach out to connect with someone, asking how they are doing and then listening well, ask a friend how you can pray for them, share a bit of your own story, maybe how you've seen God at work. You don't need perfect words—just the courage and willingness to speak with love.
