## Reflect

#### Read the full passage in your Bible - Luke 5: 1-11 NLT

What is it from these verses that grabs your heart or sparks curiosity?

In Luke 5:5 Peter says, "Because you say so, I will let down the nets." What does this say about his relationship with Jesus? How does it challenge how we normally make decisions?

Peter had just experienced failure and exhaustion... and that's when Jesus asked him to try again. When have you felt Jesus asking you to step out again, even when you felt down or discouraged?

# **Pray**

Turn to God and use the previous question as a springboard for prayer. What might God want to say to you about this? Listen carefully.

Take a moment to surrender, taking on Peter's prayer posture as your own. Whatever is going on in your life today, give that to Jesus. "Jesus...if you say you, I'll follow."

Ask God to bring to mind someone who needs to hear God's voice and his invitation to follow. Pray for them and reach out to them this week, asking the spirit to lead you.

### Live It Out

As we launch into this vision begin to pray "Jesus, move us from the safety of the shore to the deeper waters of faith." Ask God to clearly show you how He is inviting you to step into deeper waters for the sake of His mission.
