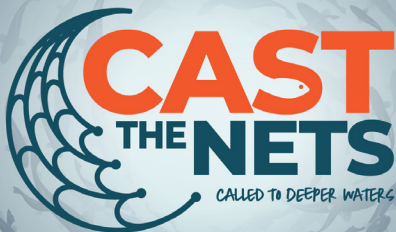

## Reflect

**Pause and be still for a moment. Invite Jesus to speak to you from His word.**

**Read the full passage in your Bible - Luke 5: 1-11 NLT**

What is it from these verses that grabs your heart or sparks curiosity?

Why do you think Jesus tells Peter to go out into deeper water rather than stay near the shore?

This was an invitation to trust Jesus...and to act on it. Imagine what that might have been like for Peter. In what area of your life is God calling you to trust him?

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## Pray

Turn to God and use the previous question as a springboard for prayer. What might God want to say to you about this? Listen carefully.

Talk to God about deeper trust, beyond what feels safe or logical. Invite him into the tension of that and to stretch your faith for greater things, for his greater purposes.

Ask God to bring to mind someone who needs to trust God to move in area of their lives that's hard or challenging. Pray for them and reach out to them this week, asking the spirit to lead you.

God is calling our church to take "Deep Water" steps of faith. How is Jesus personally calling you to step out of the boat and into the deep?
