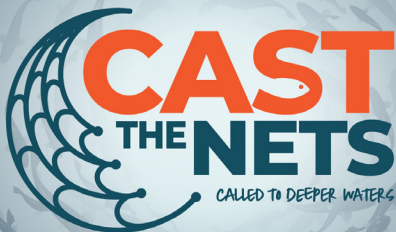

## Pray

Turn to God and use the previous question as a springboard for prayer. What might God want to say to you about this? Listen carefully.

Philippians 1:6 says, “And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns.” Talk to God about this and what it means to you.

Ask God to bring to mind someone who needs to know that God is not finished with them, that he loves them and has more for them. Pray for them and reach out to them this week, asking the spirit to lead you.
