THYATIRA: The Poor in Doctrine (Rev. 2:18-29)	Their deeds, their love, and faithfulness in service and perseverance. They are doing more now than when they started.	Tolerating false prophets who lead the people into idol worship and sexual immorality.	Those who are following her must repent quickly. Those who are not must remain faithful to sound teaching.	Wrath is coming for those who follow false teaching.	I will give you authority over the nations and gift of the morning star.
SARDIS: The Spiritually Dead (Rev. 3:1-6)	A few people who have maintianed a pure faith.	The majority have the reputation of being alive but they are dead inside.	Strengthen what little faith remains.	The Theif will come and they will not be ready.	Faithful will walk with Jesus and not be blotted out of the book of life.
PHILADELPHIA: The Spiritually Alive (Rev. 3:7-13)	Kept my word and have not denied my name despite having little strength left.	None	Hold on tight.	Allowing those who do evil to take their crown.	I have placed before you an open door. I will keep you from the hour of trial. Deliverence. I will make you a pillar in the temple of my God. Marked with the name of Christ.
LAODICEA: The Complacent (Rev. 3:14-22)	None	Lukewarm in their faith. Find their hope in worldly wealth rather than things that will last.	Turn from indifference and repent!	Failing to answer the knock at the door of their hearts.	I will invite those who overcome to sit with Him on His throne.
