OPENER

So far, we're two chapters into Revelation. What has stood out the most in this series thus far?

Do you recall who wrote the book of Revelation? What other books did this author write?

Travis had a fun exercise during his message where we all pointed at him and said, "he may be wrong," and then we pointed to ourselves and said, "I may be wrong." What did you think of this exercise?

TRUTH

Can someone read Revelation 1:13-16?

Does anyone remember what Travis said this description of Jesus reveals about him? Specifically, the robe and the sash he's wearing? (Priest and King)

Why do you think it's important to see Christ as both a perfect priest and king?

We also see that Jesus has this double-edged sword. This phrase is also used in Hebrews 4:12-13. Can someone read these verses?

By seeing Christ as a perfect priest/king and understanding Hebrews 4:12-13, we might be able to understand John's reaction to Jesus in Revelation 1:17. Can someone read this verse?

Why do you think John fell on his face before Jesus?

There are a lot of ways that we like to view Jesus. What are some of those ways?

How often do we view Jesus, like John did, in complete awe, honor, and fear? Why do you think that is?

APPLICATION

As we read this book together and walk through this series as a church, we'll ask these questions each week to help us keep our attention on Christ instead of being distracted.

How does this week's teaching keep our focus on the hope of Christ?

How does this change the way we should live our lives?
