### OPENER

This week, we started getting into some crazy visions and descriptions. As you read chapters 4 and 5, are you reminded of other literature or films? Or is this one of the only places you see descriptions/literature like this?

What were some of the images/visions of John that stood out to you the most?

### TRUTH

Read Revelation 4:1-7.

These are the first verses where John explains strange sightings and creatures. When you hear these verses, what do you think about them? What questions come to mind?

Read Revelation 4:8-11.

If verses 1-7 cause us to wonder what is happening in this scene, verses 8-11 bring things into focus. What can we gather from verses 8-11?

What can we learn and apply to our lives and the world we live in if we know this praise of God is happening, day and night, forever and ever, in the throne room of heaven?

Read Revelation 5:1-6.

Who is the Lamb in these verses?

What do you think is more significant, the contents of the scroll or that only Jesus is worthy and able to open it?

How does this add to your faith and dependence on Jesus?

### APPLICATION

As we read this book together and walk through this series as a church, we'll ask these questions each week to help us keep our attention on Christ instead of being distracted.

How does this week's teaching keep our focus on the hope of Christ?

How does this change the way we should live our lives?
