### OPENER

### TRUTH

Read Revelation 12:10-11.

What encouragement do you find from these verses?

If these verses speak of evil/sin/death being defeated by the blood of the Lamb (Christ) and the testimony of those who valued their lives over death. How important do you think the word of your testimony is? What does it look like for you to value your life over death?

Read Revelation 13:11-18.

These are definitely some of the most recognizable parts of Revelation. Why do you think so many people today are intrigued by these verses?

How can these verses actually distract Christians from what they should be most focused on?

### APPLICATION

As we read this book together and walk through this series as a church, we'll ask these questions each week to help us keep our attention on Christ instead of being distracted.
