### OPENER

What do you remember most about this week's message? Why do you think that is?

So far in this series, what has surprised you the most? What's something new you've learned?

### TRUTH

Travis opened this week with this reminder "Revelation is a collection of symbols and pictures that allow our minds to approach coming realities that are otherwise unapproachable."

What are some examples of this? How has this book, especially the last two chapters, helped your mind see what the coming kingdom will be like?

Read Revelation 21:1-4.

These verses remind us of a question Travis asked a few weeks ago. "Where is the Kingdom of Heaven?" Do you think this is a place we go to? Or does it come to us? Or is it something else?

This is a good time to remember something said in this week's sermon.

"The point is, don't overthink the elements of these symbols. Let them be symbols. What John sees is marked by absolute perfection and complete beauty. When we see it, no matter what your preferences will have been, we will all agree that this is better. This is perfect."

Read Revelation 22:1-5.

What do these verses bring to mind?

Read Revelation 22:12-17.

What do these verses cause you to think about? What do they cause you to want to do? Or do better?
