

The month of June was a very good month for our First Family. Our attendance was up significantly (8%) over the month of June in 2024. We welcomed new families to our First Family and had a number of young people make professions of faith. Our

Vacation Bible School enrollment and attendance was our biggest on record. We enrolled 277 children and 52 youth. We also had several children who accepted Jesus as their Savior. We will follow up with each of these children and their parents and will likely see many of them make their public profession of faith and be baptized. Doxology!

Speaking of VBS, many thanks to the 50 plus volunteers who made this week of ministry possible. And special thanks to Kelly Brittain who leads our VBS year after year. I believe we have the very best Bible School in our region because of Kelly's leadership and the work of our awesome volunteers!

Also, in the month of June, we paid off our Faith Forward indebtedness. Let me say that again. WE PAID OFF OUR FAITH FORWARD INDEBTEDNESS. Praise the Lord! We began giving to Faith Forward in November of 2015. Through our Faith Forward campaign, 165 families committed to give 1.4 million dollars over a 3-year period, over and above their tithes, to fund this building project. Many continued their Faith Forward giving beyond the first three years, as the overall project cost was 3.9 million. God's blessings and our obedience has seen this obligation met. We will celebrate this accomplishment on Sunday, July 20th, during the 11 AM service. I hope you will make every effort to be present as we celebrate this accomplishment and look toward our First Family's future!

Our next big ministry event is Christmas in July and will take place the week of July 23rd . This ministry is a cooperative effort of many churches and community organizations to assist 100 families in our community with food, clothing, school supplies, and household essentials in the middle of the year. This is a wonderful opportunity for us to serve and share, in Jesus' name, with those in need from our community! We have the privilege of hosting the event in our CLC as well as providing gift cards for groceries to be shared with each of the 100 families. Many thanks to Sunday school classes and individuals who have helped us provide these gift cards. If you are interested in helping with this, please contact Steven Waters through the church office.

This Sunday we will return to our "Questions" series and address the question, "What Is So Important About Baptism?" With several baptisms scheduled in the weeks to come, I hope this will be a timely message about what the Bible teaches about the meaning and importance of baptism.

Dr. Lance Cole MUSIC MINISTRY

A new favorite song of our church seems to be, "Trust in God," written by Brandon Lake and friends. The lyrics are unique in the way they state the certainty of God's faithfulness from the point of several scriptural truths. All the while, this comes while paying homage to the old hymn, "Blessed Assurance, Jesus is Mine."

There is too much in the song to dissect in this short article, but one poignant statement says, "I know the author of tomorrow has ordered my steps." This is a direct reference to Psalm 119:133 where the Psalmist writes, "Order my steps in Your word." Note that God has ordered our steps; but how? Answer: According to HIS WORD that we find in scripture. As you consider this, think on how we can know His word. It's by reading and meditating upon scripture and putting it into practice.

A second truth comes in the repetition of, "I sought the Lord, and He heard, and He answered, that's why I trust Him." One of our members asked me about this recently as he wondered aloud if we should trust God only because God had answered our prayers. While it is true that God is trustworthy whether we have seen Him answer our prayers or not, our faith is certainly strengthened when we do see God at work in our lives. Multiple biblical characters give evidence of trusting God after seeing His faithfulness in their lives.

The final scripture that the well-known singer of this song, Chris Brown, alludes to, is found in Psalm 125:2 (which is written below). Amen and amen! I encourage you to look up "Trust in God" and sing along in your private worship this week.
