SENIOR PASTOR

Many thanks to all those who helped make our Educators Appreciation Day a success. This event is great example of our church's efforts to fulfill our mission of living in pursuit of the Great Commandment and the Great Commission by serving others and sharing His love.

Our next big event for families is our Operation Christmas Child Packing Party on Sunday November 16th. The event will take place in our CLC starting at 6 PM. Our plan is to pack at least a 1000 boxes so we will need a lot of hands to help make this happen. If you have taken a box to fill yourself, please return it to the church no later than November 17th and be sure to include your \$10 for shipping. And if you or your Sunday school class would like to make a donation to help with the shipping costs (at \$10 per box we will need over \$10,000 in funds to cover shipping costs), you are welcome to do so. Just make sure your check or envelope is clearly marked "Operation Christmas Child."

The Annual Meeting of our Georgia Baptist Mission Board will be taking place next week, November 9 - 11th, at the First Baptist Church, Atlanta, GA. We will have a brief Called Conference Sunday November 9th to elect messengers as I plan to attend as a voting messenger from our church. Our partnership with some 3,600 other Georgia Baptist churches is a very important part of our Great Commission work in our state and around the world.

As you are reading this article, I am leading a "Tour of Italy" with several of our church members and a few other guests. We will be returning home on November 8th. I am considering organizing another "Footsteps of Paul" trip to Greece and Turkey for the spring of 2027. This trip would be a land and sea trip that begins in Thessalonica, Greece, and ends in Istanbul, Turkey. More details to come after the first of the year.

On Sunday morning, November 9th, we will welcome Colonel Josh Payne as the guest speaker for our Veterans Day recognition. Josh is one of our North American Mission Board endorsed chaplains. Josh and I served on staff together for three years in Chattanooga. Josh has been in the Air Force for more than 20 years and is currently stationed at the Wright-Patterson Air Force Base Dayton, Ohio.

The other side of that coin may be how God views us as individuals. The repeated statement in this Psalm is a strong example that God's love for us *endures*. A biblical definition of endure is "the ability to withstand hardship, adversity, or persecution with patience and perseverance, rather than yielding to pressure." And God's patience and faithfulness keeps up forever! It never ends and never run out. Hallelujah!


