“Living Anchored in the Faithfulness of God”

Deuteronomy 7:9 ESV

Know therefore that the LORD your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations

1.) A life anchored in the faithfulness of God knows that faithfulness is who He is, not just what He does.

Hebrews 10:23 ESV

Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful.

2.) A life anchored in the faithfulness of God holds on through life's ups and downs.

Hebrews 10:24-25 ESV

²⁴ And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, ²⁵ not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

Holding on to God's Faithfulness:

1. Remember God keeps His promises
2. Love and serve others
3. Prioritize worshipping God with the people of God
4. Keep an eternal perspective

Lamentations 3:22-23 ESV

²² *The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases;
his mercies never come to an end;
²³ they are new every morning;
great is your faithfulness.*

3.) A life anchored in the faithfulness of God is expectant for what we could still see God do.

Habakkuk 3:2 NIV

*LORD, I have heard of your fame;
I stand in awe of your deeds, LORD.
Repeat them in our day,
in our time make them known; in wrath remember mercy.*

Philippians 1:6 ESV

And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ.

4.) The cross and empty tomb of Jesus are the ultimate reminders of God's faithfulness.
