

## CRAFT IDEAS LESSON THREE

## FLIP FLOP FOLLOW HIM DAILY


Main Bible Passage: John 8:12 (NIRV)

Lesson Objective: We can follow Jesus.

**Gospel Connection:** Jesus wants us to learn more about Him (walk with Him) daily!

## **Suggested Supplies:**

🔲 shoe template	🔲 beads
cardstock or cardboard	🔲 hole punch
scissors	🔲 magnets
🔲 markers	
pipe cleaners	



## Instructions:

\*\*Before your event starts...\*\* Make copies of the shoe template on cardstock for each child. If you have preschoolers or if you're using cardboard, you may want to cut the shoe pattern out for them ahead of time.

- 1. Give each child a shoe pattern and encourage them to cut it out if it's not already done.
- 2. Use a hole punch to make 3 holes in the shoe.
- 3. Allow the children to decorate their flipflops with crayons, markers, or any materials provided.
- 4. Give each child half of a pipe cleaner and instruct them to fold it in half.
- 5. Place the bent part of the pipe in the top hole and then flip over to twist and bend it to secure it.
- 6. If beads are provided, help them place beads on each side of the "straps". Then take the two ends and put through the
- other two holes. Repeat the same process of bending and twisting so it doesn't come back out of the hole.
- 7. Preschool: the straps of the flipflop can be drawn on instead of punching holes and adding pipe cleaner.
- **8.** Finally, add a magnet to the back. You may need to add glue to help it stick.

Say: How do you get to know someone and learn more about them? (Spend time with them).

Well Jesus already knows everything about us because he created us, BUT He wants us to know more about Him too! We can learn more about Jesus by spending time with Him, or walking with Him every day. This flip flop helps us to remember when we put our shoes on, we should also be walking with God and learning more about Him too! Some of the ways we can do this are praying, going to church, and reading our Bible. Jesus wants us to learn more about Him every day.
