

Out of Context - Week #2

Jeremiah 29:4-11 (NIV)

This is what the Lord Almighty, the God of Israel, says to all those I carried into exile from Jerusalem to Babylon: 5 "Build houses and settle down; plant gardens and eat what they produce. 6 Marry and have sons and daughters; find wives for your sons and give your daughters in marriage, so that they too may have sons and daughters. Increase in number there; do not decrease. 7 Also, seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the Lord for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper." 8 Yes, this is what the Lord Almighty, the God of Israel, says: "Do not let the prophets and diviners among you deceive you. Do not listen to the dreams you encourage them to have. 9 They are prophesying lies to you in my name. I have not sent them." declares the Lord. 10 This is what the Lord says: "When seventy years are completed for Babylon, I will come to you and fulfill my good promise to bring you back to this place. 11 For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

Two Common Mistakes:

- Distorted theology The belief that Christ purchased for us not only spiritual provision but financial and physical prosperity as well.
- Disassociated theology The belief that this promise is not afforded to individual believers today.

- That often when we want removal, He wants refinement (for us).
- That often when we want removal, He wants revival (through us).

Three Postures:

- Combative Us against them.
- Conforming We become them.
- Compassionate Us for them.
