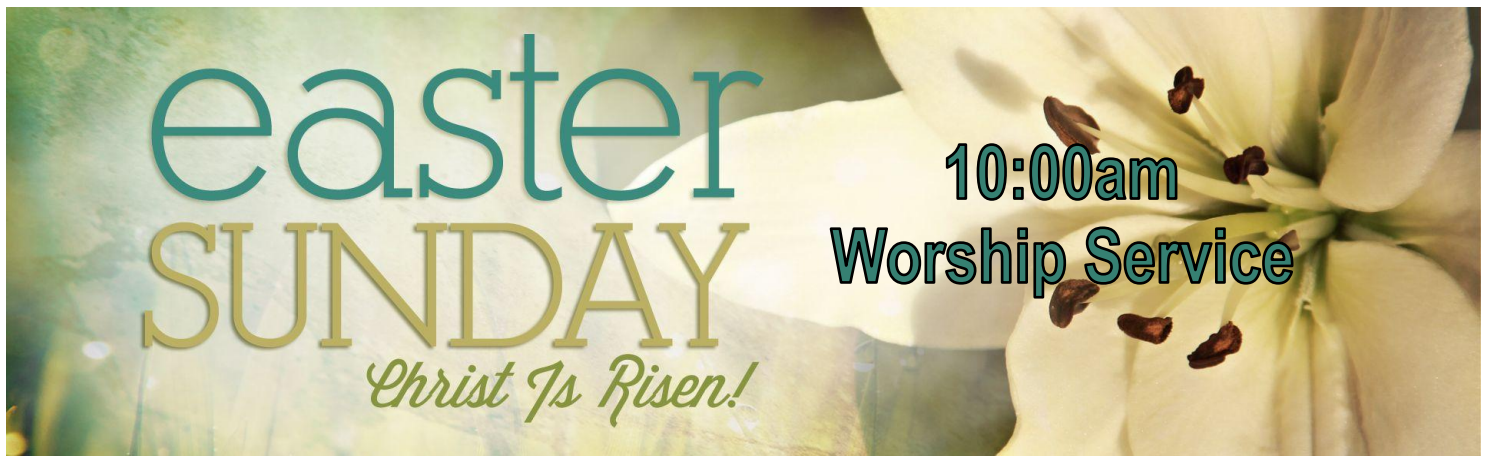

THE CHURCH COVENANT
