THE CHURCH COVENANT

We moreover engage that, when we remove from this place, we will as soon as possible unite with some other church where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's Word.

Humbly confessing our past sins, we pray for grace and strength to keep these, our holy vows, for the sake of Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

**** 3.4 MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING**

(1) One who has been received into the church as a member by Baptism, Letter, Christian Experience, Restoration or Watch-Care and is in harmony with the teachings and ministries of this church.

(2) Adult members (22 years and over) must have made a financial contribution of at least one hundred dollars (\$100.00) within the past 18 months and 15 days prior to a called church meeting. Youth members (15-21 years old) must have made a financial contribution of at least ten dollars (\$10.00) with the past 18 months and 15 days prior to a called church meeting.

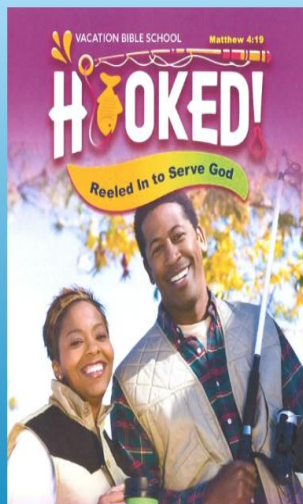
