1- Take Hannah for an Example: I Samuel 1:1-2

Now there was a certain man, of mount Ephraim, and his name was Elkanah, And he had two wives; the name of the one was Hannah, and the name of the other Peninnah: and Peninnah had children, but Hannah had no children.

I Samuel 2:5 They that were full have hired out themselves for bread; and they that were hungry ceased: so that the barren hath born seven; and she that hath many children is waxed feeble.

2- Then we have Job... Bottom line, all hell broke loose in Job's life and he lost everything... but then in Job 42:10 we read these life changing words... And The LORD Turned The Captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends: ALSO the LORD Gave Job Twice As Much as He Had Before.

3- How about HEZEKIAH? Isaac 38:1 In those days was Hezekiah sick unto death. And Isaiah the prophet the son of Amoz came unto him, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Set thine house in order: for thou shalt die, and not live. Then Hezekiah turned his face toward the wall, and prayed unto the LORD, And said, Remember now, O LORD, I beseech thee, how I have walked before thee in truth and with a perfect heart, and have done that which is good in thy sight. And Hezekiah wept sore... Then came the word of the LORD to Isaiah, saying, Go, and say to Hezekiah, Thus saith the LORD, the God of David thy father, I have heard thy prayer, I have seen thy tears: behold, I Will Add Unto Thy Days Fifteen Years.

4- And let us not forget Issac! Who in a Famine... while everyone around him was feeling sorry for themselves, complaining and waiting for something to happen... Issac Rose Up, Dug Up His Shovel, Got Him a Big Sack of Seeds, And Did The Unthinkable... What was that? And Issac Sowed in His Famine... and Reaped In The Same year 100 Fold... and THE LORD BLESSED HIM! WOW! WOW!WOW!

What do you do when the Heavens feel like brass and the earth like Iron? YOU SOW AND THEN PRAISE GOD FOR A MIRACULOUS HARVEST!

5- And what can we say about Paul and Silas, who after having done the Will of God were thrown in Prison and Put in Chains from Head to Toe... Acts 16:25-26 And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them.

And Suddenly there was a Great Earthquake, so that the Foundations of the prison were shaken: and Immediately All the Doors were Opened, and Every One's Bands were Loosed.

Sing Oh Barren and Bring Forth...

6- Someone said, I did all those things and nothing has happened... Well, maybe You need to Repent and get right with God... and then, The heavens Will Open for you once again.

Psalms 41:4 and David said, LORD, be merciful unto me: Heal my soul; for I have sinned against thee. Create in me a Clean Heart Oh God and Renew a Right Spirit within Me...

7- another person said, Pastor I'm being tormented and can hardly sleep anymore... Well, maybe you need to Forgive the person who hurt AND betrayed you... turn the Nut loose!

In Mark 11:25-26 Jesus said, And when ye stand praying, Forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven May Forgive You Your Trespases. But if Ye Do Not Forgive, Neither Will Your Father which is in heaven Forgive Your Trespases.

I hear the Lord saying... If you will Hear and Obey... I will Restore unto you the Years... not just the minutes, nor the hours, not even the days, But The Years the Enemy has Stolen From You... for I am the Lord God Almighty and Nothing Is TOO HARD OR DIFFICULT FOR ME...
