1- THINK OF ABRAHAM... a moon worshipper and idolater...

Genesis 12:1-3 "Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee: and I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing: and I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed."

Let me begin by saying, "Everything you've ever wanted is on the other side of fear. Thank God Abraham obeyed.

Hebrews 11:8 "By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, Obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went." This is why he is called the Father of Faith
