"Unless Someone Guides Me" Acts 8:25-40, ESV

Introduction: Who told you about Jesus? Who are YOU telling about Jesus? It is the mission of <u>EVERY</u> Christian to engage people for the purpose of telling others about Jesus.

1). Religious & Righteous, But Unsaved (v. 26-28).

Notice the **individuals** mentioned in this text: angel of the Lord, Philip, Candace, Holy Spirit, and Jesus.

- What is a eunuch?
- God was working in his **heart**.
- He was reading **Scripture** (Isaiah 53 to be precise).

<u>Application</u>: The Ethiopian eunuch represents many people in the modern era: they are religious, moral, inquisitive, but woefully lost and without Christ. Who in your life is lost and far from God? From a Kingdom perspective, why do you think they are in your life?

2). Someone to Guide Me (v. 29-40).

- Led by the **Spirit**, Philip goes over to him and asks if he understood what he was reading (v. 30).
- "How can I, unless someone guides me?" (v. 31).
- The response of the Ethiopian: "What prevents me from being **baptized**?" (v. 37).
- Philip was carried away by the **Spirit**; and the eunuch went on his way rejoicing (v. 39).
- Philip went about preaching the **gospel** to the towns he entered (v. 40).

Application: People all around us need someone to show them the way to Christ. Do you have a sensitivity to the leading and prompting of the Holy Spirit.
