## "A Defining Moment" Acts 9:1-9, ESV

**Introduction**: As you assess and evaluate your life to this point, have you ever experienced a "defining moment"? Maybe it was marriage, kids, a career change, an illness, or termination from a job. If you have been born again, then certainly your salvation was a life-transforming moment. In today's text, Luke provides a record of an astonishing, transforming moment in the life of a man name Saul.

## **Ideas Driven by the Text:**

## 1). DETERMINED MOTIVATION (v. 1-2).

Still breathing out **murderous** threats.

Against the **Lord's** people.

Asked for **authority** to go after believers in Damascus.

Men and/or women- to **imprison** them in Jerusalem.

<u>Application</u>: Saul was motivated by a burning passion to prevent the spread of Christianity. He was zealous to ravage and wreak havor against anyone who believed in Christ. Persecuting Christians was Saul's obsession. **What is your obsession?** What motivates you? What will you give your time? Your energies? Your resources? I hope that, as you think about it, what motivates you is related in some fashion to your love for Christ. If not, what needs to change?

## 2). DEFINING MOMENT (v. 3-9).

As Saul approached **Damascus**...

A sudden, **supernatural** light from heaven shone around him

A voice said... "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?"

"Who are you, Lord?"

"I am JESUS, whom you are persecuting."

Rise, Enter the city. You will be told what you are to do.

Those with Saul. Speechless. Heard the **voice**, but saw no one.

Saul rose. He **temporarily** lost his sight.

Led by the **hand** and was brought into Damascus.

For three days Saul was without **physical** sight, and did not eat or drink.

Application: As one commentator put it, "From **fierce persecutor** to foremost preacher of the Christian faith..." How is this even remotely possible- JESUS!
