

“What Must I Do to Be Saved?”

Acts 16:16-34

Introduction: Perhaps the most urgent question any person can and should ask is: “What must I do to be saved?” Conceivably, no question is more in need of an answer. You must ask this question now. You must avoid delay. You must ask this question before it is too late.

Key Ideas:

- 1). Acts marks the transition from the work of God provincially among the Jews, to His establishment of the universal church.
- 2). Jesus is the only way to salvation (v. 31; Acts 4:12).
- 3). The Word of God is to be declared (v. 32).
- 4). Salvation in Christ is evidenced by a change (v. 33-34).
