

# “Unflinching Determination”

## Acts 21:1-16, ESV

**INTRODUCTION:** Paul consistently displayed an unflinching determination to fulfill his divine call to herald the gospel among the Gentile nations (Acts 9:15-16). Paul’s faithfulness to the mission given to him by Christ brought many sufferings (2 Cor. 11:16-29). Today’s sermon text bears witness of Paul’s unwavering resolve and full trust in God for the outcome of his life.

1). From Miletus to Tyre (v. 1-6).

2). From Tyre to Caesarea (v. 7-14).

### Four Key Takeaways:

- ❖ Paul apparently received these so as not to deter him, but to **prepare** him for what awaited him in Jerusalem.
- ❖ As you think about your commitment to Christ, how **far** does it go?
- ❖ As you think about your trust in God, do you fully trust Him, not just for **salvation**, but for **everything** else?
- ❖ How does **obedience** fit into your life regarding the promptings of the Holy Spirit?
