

**2026-2027 DEPENDENT VERIFICATION WORKSHEET (V1 V5)**

Your 2026–2027 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm the information you reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, the financial aid administrator at your school will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the financial aid administrator at your school. Your school may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact your financial aid administrator as soon as possible to avoid delays in your financial aid.

**B. Family Size - Includes the following**

The provided criteria for “dependent children” or “other persons” mirror the requirement that family size align with the number of dependents the parent could claim on a U.S. tax return if the parent were to file a U.S. tax return at the time of completing the 2026-2027 FAFSA. As a result, the parent should not include any unborn children in the family size.

## C. Student's Income Information to Be Verified

### 1. Verification of 2024 Income Information for Student Tax Filers

**Instructions:** Complete this section if the student filed or will file a 2024 IRS income tax return(s). As part of Federal student aid eligibility, students must consent to the sharing and import of income and tax information from the IRS with the FAFSA form, even if the attempt to obtain or use such data is unsuccessful. In most cases, no further documentation is needed to verify 2024 income information transferred to the student's FAFSA from IRS data via the FA-DDX.

Make sure to request the "Return Transcript" and **NOT** the "Account Transcript." Follow the instructions to create an ID.me account if you do not already have one. - Automated Telephone Request – 1-800-908-9946. Transcript is generally received within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of the telephone request.
- Paper Request Form – IRS Form 4506T-EZ or IRS Form 4506-T. The transcript is generally received within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of the paper request form.

**2. Verification of 2024 Income Information for Students with Unusual Circumstances**

Complete this section if the student has filed or will file a 2024 income tax return with any of the following circumstances.

**Also check the box that applies:**

- The student is required to file a 2024 IRS income tax return and has been granted a filing extension by the IRS beyond the automatic six-month extension for tax year 2024 must provide:
- A signed statement listing the sources of any 2024 income and the amount of income from each source;
  - A copy of the IRS's approval of an extension beyond the automatic six-month extension for tax year 2024;

  - A **2024 IRS Tax Return Transcript** (that will only include information from the original tax return and does not have to be signed), or any other IRS tax transcript(s) that includes all of the income and tax information required to be verified; or
  - A signed copy of the 2024 IRS Form 1040 and the applicable schedules that were filed with the IRS.
- The student was the **victim of IRS tax-related identity theft**, must provide:
- A copy of the signed 2024 income tax return and applicable schedules the individual filed with the IRS, or an equivalent document provided by the IRS; **and**
  - An IRS 4674C letter (a letter from the IRS acknowledging the identity theft) or a statement signed and dated by the tax filer indicating that he or she was a victim of IRS tax-related identity theft, and the IRS is aware of it.
- The student filed Non-IRS Income Tax Returns:

A tax filer who filed an income tax return with a tax authority other than the IRS may provide a signed copy of his or her income tax return that was filed with the relevant tax authority. However, if the institution questions the accuracy of the information on the signed copy of the income tax return, the tax filer must provide the institution with a copy of the tax account information issued by the relevant tax authority before verification can be completed.

## D. Parent's Income Information to Be Verified

### 1. Verification of 2024 Income Information for Parent Tax Filers

**Important Note:** The instructions below apply to each parent (or stepparent, if applicable) included in the household. Notify the financial aid office if the parents filed separate IRS income tax returns for 2024 or had a change in marital status after December 31, 2024.

**Instructions:** Complete this section if the parents filed or will file a 2024 IRS income tax return(s). - An IRS 4674C letter (a letter from the IRS acknowledging the identity theft) or a statement signed and dated by the tax filer indicating that he or she was a victim of IRS tax-related identity theft, and the IRS is aware of it.

The parent(s) filed Non-IRS Income Tax Returns:

- A tax filer who filed an income tax return with a tax authority other than the IRS may provide a signed copy of his or her income tax return that was filed with the relevant tax authority. However, if the institution questions the accuracy of the information on the signed copy of the income tax return, the tax filer must provide the institution with a copy of the tax account information issued by the relevant tax authority before verification can be completed.
