Academic Growth Initiatives

SWU is pleased to announce the reinstatement of Academic Deans for SWU's College of Arts and Sciences, Benson School of Business, and School of Education. These academic leaders will cultivate the growth of new degree pathways and a renewed sense of vision at SWU.



The College of Arts and Sciences will be led by Dean Chad Stutz. Dr. Stutz will work with chairs of the five divisions of the College of Arts and Sciences to pursue President Barker's liberal arts vision, especially in re-imagining SWU's core curriculum.



The Benson School of Business will be led by Dean Priscilla Hammond. Dr. Hammond will work to expand undergraduate programs and cultivate opportunities for marketplace multipliers, along with improving and enhancing our existing M.B.A. and D.B.A. programs.



The School of Education will be led by Dean Greg Benson. Dr. Benson will be leading the effort to restore SWU's secondary education degree pathways, as well as developing additional undergraduate degrees to create more pathways to teaching credentials and licensure.

SWU Awarded Nationwide Grant

SWU has been awarded a \$50,000 Capacity Building Grant from Wake Forest University's Educating for Character Initiative to support its project, "From Knowledge to Wisdom and Character: Building a Transformational Core Curriculum in the Christian Liberal Arts Tradition." The grant will provide critical resources to enhance faculty development, curriculum design, and student engagement strategies that prioritize character formation as a central outcome of the university experience.

Emily Holley, SWU's growing Advancement Department has seen record-breaking success, with three times the funds raised so far this year compared to last year. After months of investment and relationship cultivation with donors, SWU received a large land gift in western North Carolina, the largest single gift in the school's history. In addition, SWU's partnership with the Wesleyan Church Education Investment Fund continues, with \$1,158,000 contributed to SWU this fiscal year.

LEA WINS CONFERENCE AWARD

Happy Lea was named Conference Carolinas Outdoor Track & Field Freshman of the Year after two First Team All-Conference finishes in the 110 meter hurdles and 400 meter hurdles. He broke the Warrior school record in the 110 meter hurdles and received U.S. Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association All-Region Honors.
