- 2. Only letters and special characters may be printed on the plaques and shall consist of highest rank, name, unit of assignment, branch of service, and dates of service.

- 3. Some form of proof of service, such as copy of DD Form 214; picture in uniform; copy of orders; affidavit; etc. will be required to have a plaque approved and ordered upon payment.
- 4. Eligibility: Plaques will be made and installed for loved ones living or deceased with documented military service (see 3 above) and connected to SWU by being a(n):
  - Alumnus or related to a SWU Alumnus
  - Current or previous faculty or staff member and/or family member of a SWU employee
  - Friend or donor of SWU who has demonstrated a continuous connection with the campus for 5 years or more (connection may be demonstrated by formal partnership, consistent donations, a municipality or government relationship that is clearly documented, business relationship that is long standing and mutually positive.) (Or an organization or person that donates directly to the memorial fund at the value of 25% of its total worth thus eliminating the 5 year stipulation.)
  - Individual who has retired from the military with 20 or more years of service or a person who was Military Chaplain, POW, MIA, KIA, or Military Disabled
