Covenant member Andy Reed is serving as an intern with Reformed University Fellowship (RUF) at University of Tennessee-Chattanooga. In October, all 172 RUF interns joined together in Colorado for a time of training.

One of Andy's favorite sessions was on "Combating Biblical Illiteracy" where they learned how to help students grow in their Bible comprehension skills. Another blessing that came with the training was an opportunity for Andy to meet with his prayer group in person. During the semester, he and three other interns from various campuses had been meeting by phone or online to pray for one another.

An important part of the RUF internship is a study program, and October's study book was Andy's favorite so far. The book, Dark Clouds Deep Mercy, gives a four-step process in how to lament properly. Andy got to lead one of their freshmen fellowship meetings on this same topic.

Their campus RUF group recently had an opportunity to take part in a service project, where they helped to remove debris and clean up a local house for a family.


Andy would appreciate prayer for the following:
