Missions

North Care Women's Clinic is a local non-profit Christian ministry offering God's help, hope and healing to people experiencing an unexpected pregnancy. Their mission is to compassionately empower individuals to make healthy and informed decisions regarding their pregnancies, and to be a leader in promoting positive sexual values. In their annual report, North Care is praising God for hitting a milestone of over one thousand clients last year. Sixty-two percent of those clients at risk for abortion chose to carry their babies. They also used their new 3D ultrasound machine to show babies to over four hundred pregnant women and started two new client programs. One is a five-session pregnancy and parenting counseling program, and the other includes medical assessment and emotional support to women struggling after an abortion.

One memorable story from the past year involved a client who drove over two hours with her boyfriend to North Care because they were able to provide an ultrasound the next day. She already had the abortion pills ordered but wanted to see what was going on with her pregnancy. She and her boyfriend were moved by what they saw and ultimately decided to keep the baby!

Please continue to pray for this ministry and for the clients that they serve.
