Missions

Flavien and Inyange are missionaries stationed in the U.S. serving churches and church planters in sensitive countries.

In March Flavien traveled to East Asia to teach a course on “The Relationship of the Old and New Testaments” to church leaders from an under-resourced area of the country. This was part of a series of four courses showcasing the kind of training a new seminary set to start in the fall will provide to the leaders of the churches it is meant to serve. Flavien was invited to be a regular (yearly) instructor for the seminary and to work to recruit more instructors.

Flavien was in Pennsylvania in April for a partner church's “missions emphasis week”, during which he ministered God's Word and gave a report on the Sunday.

Flavien was invited to be a speaker at a conference in Hong Kong in the fall that serves five hundred or more pastors from the mainland each year. Flavien will be giving three addresses on the topic of “The Deceitfulness of Sin”. From Hong Kong he will fly to Java to meet colleagues to discuss their church planting and theological education plans.

-for Flavien's colleague in East Asia who recently reported that various churches and ministries that he and his wife are serving are under duress from the authorities, so much so that he and his family had to go into hiding
