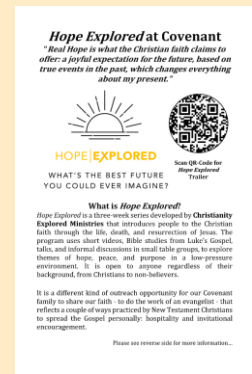
Operation Christmas Child Collection Week

Hope Explored at Covenant

Hope Explored is a three-week series developed by Christianity Explored Ministries that introduces people to the Christian faith through the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. The program uses short videos, Bible studies from Luke's Gospel, talks, and informal discussions in small table groups, to explore themes of hope, peace, and purpose in a low-pressure environment. It is open to anyone regardless of their background, from Christians to non-believers.



During the Christmas season we will probably have visitors at Covenant that may have spiritual questions and who would be open to an easy way to explore Christianity in a low-pressure environment. In addition, many of us probably know people who might be open to attending a series of meetings like this. **A start in late January is being considered.**

This Sunday Pastor Rohrman will preach from **Philippians 1:3–11, 4:10–20** and his sermon title is ***A Thankful Pastor***. He writes, "Paul didn't need a Thanksgiving meal to remind him to share what he was thankful for. He does this in almost all of his letters, and it is always focused on people and God's work of grace in and through them. In these familiar passages, Paul thanks the Lord for the Philippians' partnership with him, not only financially but in all ways needed for the ministry of the Gospel. He also encourages them with his confidence in God's provision for them—again, not only materially, but also spiritually—by the grace of Christ and for the glory of his name. These passages provide a natural opportunity for any pastor to express his gratitude for and to encourage a congregation that has supported and partnered with him in the ministry of the gospel."
