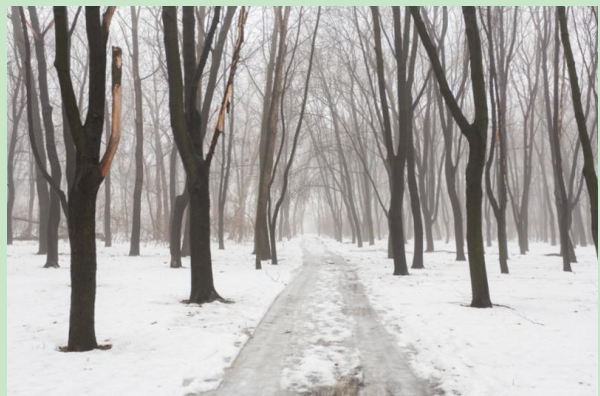


Covenant Update

conditions change, any updates will be posted to our website. Thank you for your prayers that we may be able to worship our Lord together!



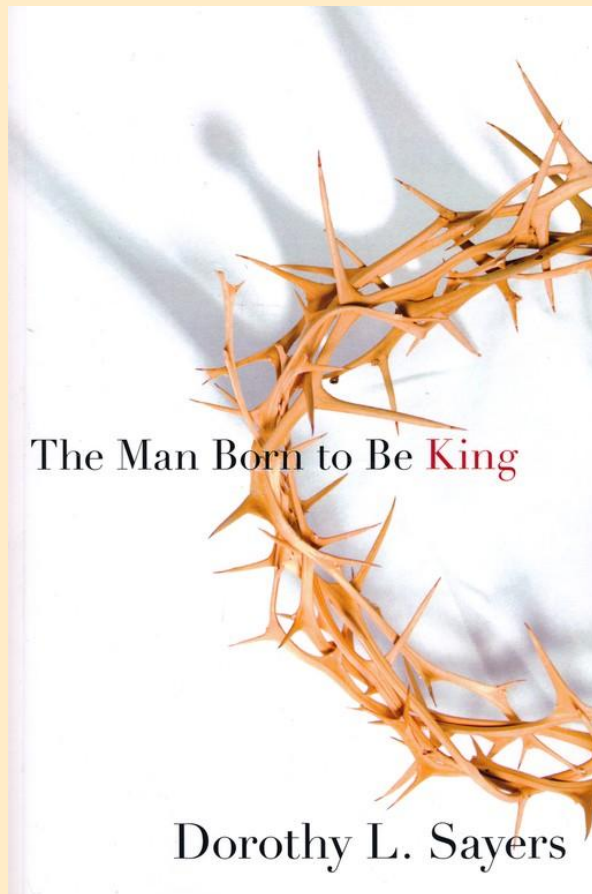

In our study of The Gospel according to John, we will focus on the distinctive characteristics and unique contributions of John's account of the life, death, and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ. We will also consider how John's theology has helped shape the Church's understanding of the nature of God and the person and work of Christ, among other themes.

The Man Born to Be King
by Dorothy Sayers

Before television became the staple of home entertainment in the 1950s, families gathered around the radio to listen to programs featuring everything from daring adventure to serious literary endeavor. During World War II, Dorothy Sayers sought to use the radio to bring hope to a troubled world through a dramatic portrayal of the life of Christ. She wrote a series of 12 radio plays covering the time from Jesus' birth through His resurrection. At Covenant we have performed the first play, *Kings in Judaea*, numerous times in the past 30 years. This class will introduce us to some of the other plays in the series. We will spend class time reading together and then discussing the themes and ideas that Sayers highlights in her writing. No need to read anything in advance and feel free to simply listen rather than reading a particular part.

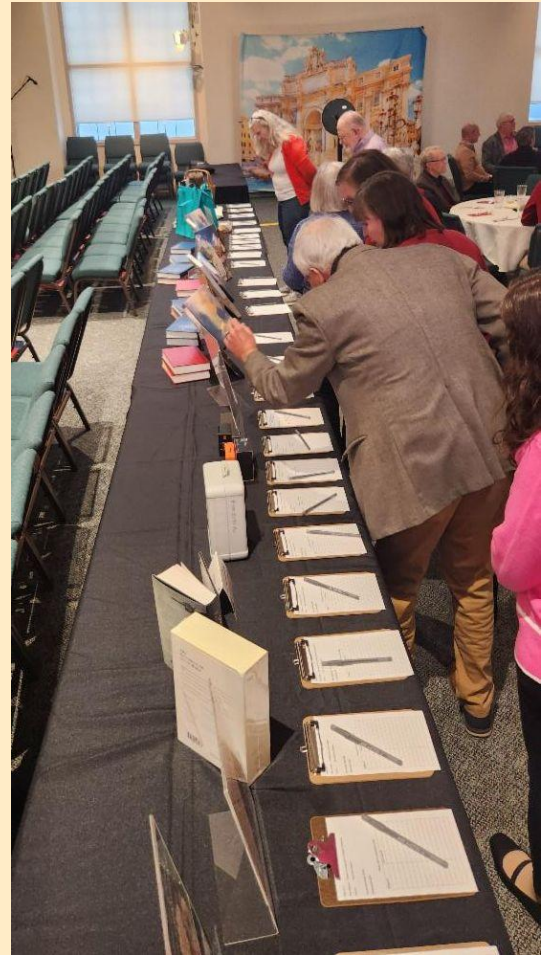
