#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

**General:** This person must articulate and exemplify a life of faith in Christ. They must be spiritually mature, humble, trustworthy, able to follow, and willing to lead.

**Ministry Specific:** We are looking for individuals who have a genuine passion for ministry and a desire to serve the local church. While this opportunity is especially well-suited for those exploring a future in ministry, we also welcome applicants who are eager to contribute to the growth of the church as committed, high-capacity volunteers. Strong communication skills and organizational ability are important for success in this role. Applicants should have completed at least one year of college, with preference given to those pursuing ministry or a Bible-related field of study.
