MATTHEW 12:10–12; JOHN 5:5–9

LEARN THE WORD

John 3:36

Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.

- On the Sabbath day, Jesus healed a man who couldn't walk. The Pharisees were upset with the man and with Jesus for breaking their rules.
- Jesus said He is lord of the Sabbath, and He told the Pharisees that it is lawful to do good on the Sabbath day.

WHAT YOU HEARD IN THE WORD

OUTWORD FOR FAMILY DISCUSSION

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. Why was the man lying by the pool?

Answer: *He thought the water in the pool could heal him.*

2. Why were the Pharisees upset with the man after Jesus healed him? What did they see him doing?

Answer: *He was carrying his bed on the Sabbath.*

3. Did Jesus care more about following rules or about loving and helping people?

Answer: *Loving and helping people.*
