Wednesday, September 17, 11:00AM-12:30PM, Family Life Center

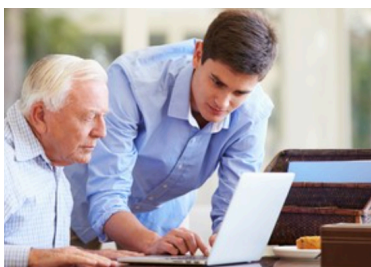

Tuesday, September 23, 11:00AM, Depart in church van at 10:30AM

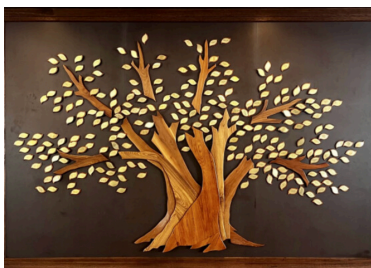
