The Parking team makes a great first impression by guiding and directing parents and students through the parking, pickup, and drop-off experience so they feel welcome, valued, and safe. You will play a vital role in accomplishing our two wins by creating an engaging experience and setting up students to enter into transformational relationships with God and others.

Here's how we do it:

Before

- Read weekly communications from you leader prior to student services.
- Check in, wear your nametag, attend huddles, and participate in ongoing training meetings.
- Communicate scheduling conflicts with your team leads and manage you schedule on My.eaglebrookchurch.com.
- Come dressed ready to serve (welcoming, appropriate, and weather appropriate). Avoid politically motivated or costume attire. (Costume attire is recommended for parties or special events.)
- Ensure parking lot is set up with the correct signage and cone placement.

During

- Direct cars with clear signals as they enter the parking lot from your assigned area.
- Always smile and greet people as they enter and exit the lot. Welcome and engage students and parents as they get out of their cars.
- Be on the lookout for students or parents who may need special assistance.
- Carefully watch pedestrian traffic and give clear instructions regarding when and how to safely cross traffic.
- Make sure the parking lot is safe, and clear of student at the time of service.

After

- Connect with parents as they wait for students' dismissal.
- Provide a safe and friendly farewell to each student as they leave our buildings.
- Return your nametag, parking gear, and supplies to designated location.
- Celebrate – share stories of impact.
- Assess and share feedback with your team and team lead.
