Set Up an Engaging Atmosphere

- Set up all environmental pieces in time for the start of services (check-in stations and signs, furniture, lighting, pipe and drape, lobby games, and parking signs).
- Maintain the organization and cleanliness of the student ministries' storage area.
- Helping to create a fun atmosphere for parties and special events.

Tear Down Items to Restore Environment

- Tear down, clean, and store all environmental pieces in proper storage area at the end of services and leave the campus equal to or better than before.
- Pick up trash left by students or volunteers.
- Maintain the organization and cleanliness of the student ministries' storage area.
