Purpose: Inspire and lead Peace Lutheran Church through music and worship to the glory, praise and honor of God.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

- Execute worship for Peace Lutheran, in both a traditional and modern style, including but not limited to, Sunday mornings, mid-week, or other opportunities.
- Lead and rehearse worship leadership, including, Adult Choir, and coordinating with Organist, Adult Handbell Choir, Adult Praise Team, and other special groups for opportunity to lead in worship.
- Train volunteers in choral techniques, appreciation of sacred music, Lutheran traditions, and leadership of worship.
- Serve as a music resource to groups, programs, and committees such as Vacation Bible School, Red Apple School, Children and Student Ministries, weddings, funerals, etc.
- Support worship volunteers including, but not limited to: ushers, altar guild, readers, acolytes, musicians and other necessary volunteers.
- Administer annual music budget, including working with Director of Operations for budget planning for the next fiscal year.
- Supervise the maintenance of music ministry assets, including requesting necessary work to be done with the Director of Operations.
- Other duties and responsibilities as requested by the Senior Pastor and mutually agreed upon.

Qualifications

- Minimum Bachelor's degree or equivalent in music.
- Experience with choral, instrumental, and contemporary music groups.
- Experience working with teams of staff and volunteers.
- Knowledge of and experience with Lutheran musical traditions, theology and worship.

Expectations

- This is a salaried, part-time, non-exempt position that reports directly to the Senior Pastor.
- Maintain and cultivate healthy relationship with the Staff and Congregation.
- Faithfully, truthfully, and with integrity lead the music and worship ministry of Peace.
