Small Group Questions

Opener Question: What's the most uncomfortable thing, for you, about asking for help?

1. What are some things that are at stake when we ask for help from others?
2. What's something that makes it difficult to ask God for help?
3. We talked about how experiencing the work of God requires humility, vulnerability, and trust in God. Do you agree? Explain.
4. In this particular case, Naaman experienced healing, but that's not everyone's experience, even with Jesus. Some people don't get the answer or the outcome they wanted. Do you think those people can still experience the work of God? How does humility, vulnerability, and trust play a role in a situation where it doesn't work out like we wanted?
5. What do you think it looks like for you to choose **humility, vulnerability**, and **trust** — whether you're in a season of desperate hope (like Naaman) or if things are just okay?

Not everyone is going to walk away from this small group feeling like they're covered and God's good and has them. Some will walk away with questions and tension, and that's okay. Let's stay tuned in and make sure we follow up with students.
