Goal of the lesson

For students to respond to Jesus and identify and explore ways to share Him in their lives...What's one small contribution we can make to the story of God in our lives?



Scripture

Luke 8:1-3, 23:55-56, 24:10



Small Group Questions

Welcome question: How would you describe your relationship with God? What does this relationship mean to you? (you could use a 1-10 scale to help articulate closeness, relevance, engagement. You could have them write down 3 adjectives and then share...)

Discussion:

- Do you ever feel inadequate in your faith or relationship with God? Explain.
- What will you remember about Joanna?
- Who, in our series, did you most relate to/feel most challenged or inspired by? Explain. -- Hosea, Hagar, Daniel, Naaman, Mordecai, or Joanna.
- Who inspires you in your faith? Of the people we've studied or in life in general. Why?
- What's one small contribution you think you can make this week to making Jesus known around you? Big or small...obvious or subtle.
