

Potter's House:

Description of the Potter's House CCLE:

The schedule will be what fits the needs of Potter's House at that time. They conduct projects throughout the summer months that various groups participate in as trips come and go. Our group may assist in some construction work (building bathhouses, clearing land, constructing shelters, etc.).

They will either continue the work from a previous trip group or will start work that other groups will finish. There will likely be education excursions to various communities as well as delivering meals and going on prayer walks. There will be opportunities to decompress and even go into the local market.

The team can expect to learn more about the work of Potter's House to support local families and children, making sure that they have access to basic needs and education. They can also expect to meet with and get to know individual families.

Details:

- **TRIP LEADER:** Blaire Jenkins
- **WHEN:** July 6-13
- **WHO:** Open to current students currently in 9th-12th grade (Age 14 at the time of the trip)
- **HOW MANY:** 16 students, 4 adults
- **FUNDRAISING AMOUNT:** This amount may range between \$3000-\$3600.
- **LOGISTICS:**
 - Transportation: We will be flying out of and back into Boston Logan. Students will need to be dropped off and picked up at the airport as we are not parking vehicles there for the week. We will be flying into Guatemala City.
 - Eligibility for this trip:
 - Participation in another CCLE or other week-long mission trip is *required*.
 - All students applying will...
 - Fill out the application form
 - Submit two non-parent references
 - Submit a one-page essay on a prompt that you will receive with the application
 - Sit for an interview with Blaire
 - Have a valid Passport
 - Students regularly serve somewhere (Kidstown, local non-profit, etc.)
 - Students who apply for this trip but don't get invited to join are still able to go to the Philly Project, The Root Cellar, or student-lead with Boston Project or WorkcampNE.
 - A list of Vaccinations/Boosters will be recommended (including but not limited to flu, COVID, Hep A, Tetanus, Diphtheria, Rabies, Typhoid, and Malaria precautions)
