God's Covenant with David 2 Samuel 7:1-17

I. David's Heart for God - 7:1-3

- His heart rejoiced in God's blessings 1
 God gave him his throne & a palace
 God gave him rest from all his enemies
- 2. His heart's desire was to build a temple for God –2 It concerned him that he had a palace
 But the ark of God dwells in a tent
- Prophet, Nathan, encouraged him to build 3
 Nathan recognized "God was with him"
 He was a man after God's own heart
 He believed God would let him build this temple

II. God has a Message for David – 7:4-17

But God spoke to Nathan that night – 4-7
 Tell David, my servant:

"Would you build me a house to dwell in?" I have not lived in a house since I brought My people out of Egypt

I have been moving about in a tent for my dwelling Did I speak a word with the leaders of my people Israel

"Why have you not built me a house of cedar?"

2. Here is God's message for David - 8-11

"I took you from the pasture, from following sheep" - 8
"That you should be prince over my people Israel"
I have been with you wherever you went - 9
To cut off your enemies from before you

"I will make for you a great name" - 9

Like the name of the great ones of the earth

"I will appoint a place for my people Israel" – 10

So they may dwell in their own place (Israel)

And be disturbed no more

And violent men afflict them no more

Like in the time of the judges – 11

"I will give you rest from all of your enemies"

- 3. God's promise to build David's house 12-15
 - (1). For his immediate offspring 12

When David is gone, in death

God will establish his son's kingdom –Solomon

He will build a house for God's name

(2). For his line forever (God's Son– Jesus) – 13

"I will establish His throne forever"

Solomon's line will continue until Messiah comes

- (3). Solomon's line may fall in sin & God will discipline 14 But God's steadfast love will not depart from him–15
- 4. David's House & Kingdom shall be made sure forever 16

This promise is made sure in God's Son
Jesus comes in the line of David – Matt. 1:1-17
Paul speaks of this promise in Acts 13:22-23

Acts 13:22- ESV 2

"2 And when he had removed him (Saul), he raised up David to be their king, of whom he testified and said, 'I have found in David the son of Jesse a man after my heart, who will do all my will.' ²³ Of this man's offspring God has brought to Israel a Savior, Jesus, as he promised"

III. This is God's Eternal Plan - Psa. 2

- 1. Men will resist and fight against God's Plan But He will set His king upon His Holy hill
- 2. God invites humans to bow their knee And submit to His Son, receiving His gift of eternal life
- 3. When He comes to earth again, He comes to reign Rev. 19:11-19

 After judgment He will rule over earth 1,000 years.

After judgment He will rule over earth 1,000 years Rev. 20:1-6

 After God creates a New Heaven & a New Earth – Rev. 21-22

His Son shall rule & reign forever (eternally)
Those who rest their faith in Him will reign with
Him – Rev. 22:3-5
