God's Timetable Daniel 9

I. 70 Years in Exile - 9:1-2

- First year of Darius the Mede 1
 Now king over the realm of Chaldeans
 Reign of Babylon ended with Belshazzar Dan. 5
- 2. Daniel read what Jeremiah wrote 2
 God told Jeremiah exile would last 70 yrs. –
 Jer. 25:11-12

Jerusalem would lay in ruins & Israel would be in Babylon

But God would defeat Babylon & release Israel

- 3. Daniel turned to God in prayer 9:3-15 Confessing their sin & acknowledging God's discipline
- 4. Praying for God's forgiveness & His mercy 9:16-19 Asking God to act for His own name-sake

II. 70 Weeks are Determined - 9:20-24

- Angel Michael appears to Daniel 20-23 Comes to reveal God's message Assuring God's love for Daniel
- 70 sevens (heptads) any group of 7 24
 Similar to "dozen" in English
 While 70 years of exile is over,
 God is not finished with Daniel's people or with their holy city (Jerusalem)
- 3. God's purpose for Israel goes deeper 24
 Sin has broken fellowship between God and man
 This is true for Israel and all of sinful humans
 "To finish the transgression, to put an end to sin, to
 atone for iniquity"

A sacrifice for sin must be offered with God's acceptance

5. God's plan must include perfect fulfillment

- 4. God's plan is more than negative 24
 "To bring in everlasting righteousness"
 Reconciliation means righteousness must prevail
 If humans are to live eternally with a righteous God
- "To seal both vision & prophet"

 Every promise of God must come to fulfillment
 "To anoint a most holy place"

 A place where Holy God & Redeemed humans can
 meet
- 6. God's commitment to Daniel must fit within 70 x 7 24

By the time we come to the end of 70 weeks The 70th week brings us to the return of Jesus Christ

III. 7 Weeks, Return & Rebuild - 9:25

- God's plan must assure return from exile 25
 And rebuilding of the Temple and the City
- 49 years to build Temple & City
 First return authorized by Cyrus, King of Persia
 This was prophesied by Isaiah Isa. 44:28
 Permission granted to rebuild the Temple
 Led by Zerubbabel & Ezra Ezra 6:15-18

3. City walls of Jerusalem were rebuilt
Under leadership of Nehemiah
Permission granted by King Artaxerxes – Neh. 2:1-8
Rebuilding was faced by resistance
But the walls were completed around the city in 52
days – Neh. 6:15

IV. 62 Weeks to Messiah - 9:26

 62 x 7 = 483 years unto presentation of Messiah Messiah here is called "Anointed One" Zechariah predicted His coming on a donkey – Zech. 9:9

He shall "be cut off" rejected as the Messiah And He shall be crucified

God's plan required this sacrifice of His Son This deals with the removal of the sin issue

This rejection will create a break in the 70 weeks
 Jesus weeps over Jerusalem and announces the break
 – Lk. 19:41-44

Weeps because they could have known this event from Daniel 9

Note Jesus had said "My time is not yet"
He now says "you missed the time of your visitation"
Destruction of Temple & Jerusalem by Titus – 70 ad

- 3. Daniel also notes this break in time 9:26
 "People of the prince who is to come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary" This will. Not come until 70 ad.
 "Its end shall come with a flood"
- 4. "And to the end there shall be war."

"Desolations are decreed"
The Prince of Peace has been cut off
This includes all of the battles Israel has faced since
Their return

V. One Week Remains - 9:27

1. "He" "Prince who is to come" – 26-27

He is linked with those who destroyed the city & the sanctuary

The Gentile nations who have dominated Israel "He shall make a strong covenant with many for one week"

This the 70th week of Daniel's prophecy. This is a 7 year period

This covenant may give Israel permission to have a temple

- 2. He shall break the covenant at half 27 "By putting an end to sacrifice and offering"
- He turns on Israel as a desolator
 Note the warning of Jesus Matt. 24:15-22
 This brings on the Great Tribulation 3 ½ years
- 4. God will bring judgment on this desolator 27 This desolator is called "Anti-Christ" in N.T.
- 5. The 70th week ends the Tribulation Rev. 19:11-16
 With the return of Jesus Christ to reign 19:16
 He comes with heaven's army
 To cast this desolator into the lake of fire 19:20
