To The End of the Earth Acts 10:24-11:18

i. Peter Meets Cornelius - 10:23-29

- Peter leaves on next day 10:23
 Goes with the 3 visitors to Caesarea
 Some brothers from Joppa go also
 They will be witnesses later
- Following day they reach Caesarea 24
 Cornelius was expecting them & invited family & friends
- Cornelius bowed to worship Peter 25-26
 No doubt saw him as a messenger from God
 Peter would not allow worship "I too am a man"
- 4. Peter introduced to those gathered 27-29 "You know, unlawful for Jew to visit a Gentile" "But God has shown me, I should not call any Person common or unclean" Indicates he understood the message in the sheet

"So when I was sent for, I came without objection"

5: Peter wants to know why he was here - 29

II. Cornelius Answers Peter - 10:30-33

- Relates appearance of the angel 30-32
 "Four days ago about this hour" (9th hour)
 "I was praying in my house"
 A man in bright clothes appeared (angel)
 "Cornelius, your prayer has been heard"
 "Your alms have been remembered before God"
 "Send to Joppa & ask for Simon who is called Peter"
 He is lodging in the house of Simon, a tanner,
 by the sea
- "So I sent for you at once, you have been kind enough to come""Therefore we are all here in the presence of Go

"Therefore we are all here in the presence of God to hear all you have been commanded by the Lord" - 33

III. Peter Preaches Christ to Gentiles - 10:34-43

- Peter declares God's message is for all nations 34
 He has come to understand God shows no partiality
 In every nation, anyone who fears God & does right
 He is acceptable with God (like Cornelius)
- 2. God brought His good news first to Israel 35-36 His Son, Jesus Christ came through Israel He came as promised to reconcile (peace) man to God

He has proclaimed His Son as Lord of all

- 3. You know how this Jesus came to Israel 37-38

 How He went through all Judea, beginning in Galilee

 After the baptism that John proclaimed

 God anointed Jesus with the Holy Spirit & power- 38

 With that power He went about doing good

 Healing all who were oppressed by the devil

 For God was with Him
- 4. We are witnesses of all He did among the Jews 39

- But they rejected Him & crucified Him
- 5. God raised Him from the dead on the 3rd day–40-41 Made Him to appear, not to all, but to us as witnesses He ate and drank with us after He rose from the dead
- 6. He commanded us to preach to the people 42 And testify that He is One appointed by God to be judge of living & dead
- 7. To Him all the prophets bear witness 43
 That everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins through His name

IV. Holy Spirit is Given to Gentiles - 10:44-48

- While Peter was still speaking 44
 Holy Spirit fell on all who heard the word
 Nothing Peter did for them to receive Holy Spirit
 No mention of prayer or laying on of hands
 Fell on all who "heard the word"
 "Heard" as is to receive what was heard
- 2. Peter's Jewish companions were witness 45-46 They were amazed when they heard the sign gift,

speaking in tongues

3. Peter recognized baptism as sign of acceptance–47-48
They were baptized in the name of Jesus Christ
They asked Peter to remain for some days

V, Peter Reports in Jerusalem – 11:1-18

- Believers heard about Peter & Gentiles 1-3
 The circumcision party criticized Peter
 Because he met with uncircumcised & ate with them
- 2. Peter's explanation in detail 4-12
 He related the full story of the vision 4-9
 Sheet let down from heaven with animals
 A voice said "Rise Peter, kill and eat"
 He spoke of his refusal to eat what is unclean
 Voice said, "What God has made clean do not call common"

He told them it was repeated 3 times – 10
At that moment 3 men appeared from Caesarea – 11
Holy Spirit told me to go & 6 witnesses went al- 12

- 3. He told them about the angel's visit 13-14 Angel told Cornelius to send for Peter Telling him where to find him in Joppa Told him Peter would deliver a message Telling Him & his Household them how to be saved
- 4. Peter related to them what happened 15-17
 As he began to speak the Holy Spirit fell on them 15
 Just as He fell on Jewish believers
 Reminded them of God's Word from John the Baptist-16
 How he baptized with water but Jesus will baptize

with the Holy Spirit
Peter concluded if God is saving Gentiles he must
not resist – 17

Response of Jerusalem believers – 18
 They fell silent – no further rebuttal
 They glorified God, He has "granted repentance that leads to life"
