DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1) What made Jesus’ ride into Jerusalem a sacred journey?
- 2) In Luke 19:37 the multitude of disciples rejoice and praised God “for all the mighty works that they had seen.” What did the disciples recognize through the “mighty works?” How should we respond today to Jesus’ mighty works?
- 3) Today, people like to refer to or quote Scripture without knowing the truth about what it says. Jesus wept over what people didn’t understand or obey. What spiritual ignorance would He weep over today? What don’t people understand that will eventually bring them ruin?
- 4) Of all the reasons that Jesus had to be angry at the people in the temple, His was that the temple was to be a “house of prayer” but had become a profit-making enterprise. What does it mean that the tabernacle and temple were to be a house of prayer? And what does this imply about what God wants for us today?
