Ephesians 5:15-20 NIV	“In essentials, unity; (1 Corinthians 12:12-13) in non-essentials, liberty; (Romans 14:1) in all things, charity.” (John 13:34) Opening Questions: Describe a time where you followed God’s leading – “against your better judgement” – and you saw the blessings of God as a consequence. Read the text completely, then come back and discuss the questions.
¹⁵ Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise,	What is living wisely? What is living unwisely(foolishly)? (Proverbs 9:10, Psalm 14:1, Proverbs 1:7, Psalm 111:10) Why do we need to pay careful attention to how we live? How do you personally take steps to see that you are living wisely
¹⁶ making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil.	How is your time management? What are things that eat away at your time? Do you have things you spend your time doing that help point your mind to Christ? How about things that take your mind off of Christ?

¹⁷ Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is. ¹⁸ Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit, ¹⁹ speaking to one another with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit. Sing and make music from your heart to the Lord,	Do you think the Lord is asking you to lay anything down for His sake? Why can it be so hard to give things up? Why do you think it is important to understand that the days are evil? How should this effect the way we live? What does it take to understand the Lord's will? (2 Peter 1:19-21, John 14:26, 1 Cor. 2:10-13, Eph. 1:17-18, Colossians 1:9-10) What are the appeals of getting drunk? What kind of living does that produce? What are the appeals of being Spirit filled? What kind of living does that produce? Why can opposites be appealing to us? (Gal. 5:17) Why do we need to be speaking to one another about the things of God? What benefits have you received when you've worshipped together? How does praise change our attitude?
