Philippians 2:5-8

⁵ In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus:

⁶ Who, being in very nature^[a] God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage;

⁷ rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature^[b] of a servant,

being made in human likeness.

⁸ And being found in appearance as a man,

he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—

even death on a cross!

- How does Jesus's attitude provide the perfect antidote or opposite to satan's pride?"
- "The sermon identified the enemy's two main strategies as **Lies** and **Intimidation**. Which of those two do you feel is more effective against you personally? Why?"
- Get specific about the lies. What is one recurring negative, accusing, or fearful thought the enemy whispers to you? (e.g., 'You're not good enough,' 'God is disappointed in you,' 'Your past defines you'). Now, what is a specific truth from Scripture that directly counters that lie?"

James 4:7-8
"Submit yourselves, then, to God.
Resist the devil, and he will flee

from you. Come near to God and he will come near to you."

The order of operations here is critical: **Submit, then Resist.** Why can't we effectively resist the devil if we haven't first submitted to God?

Ephesians 6:10-17

¹⁰ Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. ¹¹ Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. ¹³ Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. 14 Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, ¹⁵ and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. ¹⁶ In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which

you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. ¹⁷ Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.
