Opening Question →	When you consider what it means to go deeper as a Christian, what do you usually think of?
Read: Hebrews 5:11-6:3	<p><b>Question:</b> Take a moment and look at the elementary foundations the author lists in 6:1-2. Why do you think they list these specific doctrines? (Cleansing rites likely refers to baptism)</p> <p><b>Question:</b> Often spiritual growth is confused with increasing in knowledge. What are some areas believers try to increase in knowledge in hopes of spiritual growth?</p>
Read: Hebrews 6:4-8 Read: Mark 4:1-20	<p><b>Question:</b> This passage in Hebrews has a lot of debate surrounding it as it seems to have implications about the perseverance of Christian's salvation. However, when we take it with the Parable of the Sower in mind, how are these verses related to the previous verses in 5:11-6:3? (If you need guidance here watch this section of the sermon).</p>
Read: Hebrews 6:9-12	<p><b>Question:</b> Loving God also must include loving others. Who are people in your life that God may be calling you to love and be Jesus to?</p>
