Hebrews 1:8-12

⁸ But about the Son he says, “Your throne, O God, will last for ever and ever; a scepter of justice will be the scepter of your kingdom. ⁹ You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness; therefore God, your God, has set you above your companions by anointing you with the oil of joy.”

¹⁰ He also says, “In the beginning, Lord, you laid the foundations of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands. ¹¹ They will perish, but you remain; they will all wear out like a garment. ¹² You will roll them up like a robe; like a garment they will be changed. But you remain the same, and your years will never end.”

What does this verse say about us, if we are made in God’s Image?

Read Hebrews 1:8-12

How is this showing the Son is more than just a man?

Deuteronomy 6:4-5 –

“Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, *the Lord is one*. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.

John 17:9-11

⁹ I pray for them. I am not praying for the world, but for those you have given me, for they are yours. ¹⁰ All I have is yours, and all you have is mine. And glory has come to me through them. ¹¹ I will remain in the world no longer, but they are still in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name, the name you gave me, so that they may be one as we are one.

How can Deuteronomy 6:4-5 – be understood if there are three persons to God?

Since God is Trinity – God has always been relational. – Christianity is the only religion that claims the One true God to be Trinitarian.

What are some of the implication if God was not Trinitarian?

How does this understanding enlighten us to the differences between Islam and Christianity? and How do these differing understandings of God totally change how one views God?

John 17:20-24

²⁰ “My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, ²¹ that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. **May they also be in us** so that the world may believe that you have sent me. ²² I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one—²³ I in them and you in me—so that they may be brought to complete unity. Then the world will know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me. ²⁴ “Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world.
