Jesus Came to Give His Life for All Peoples
John 11:45-57

Read John 11:45-57

- I. **Not all believe in Jesus** (vv.45-48).
 - a. Why is it that some believe in Jesus and others don't?
 - b. What was the reason for the unbelief? Did Jesus not give enough information?
 - c. According to John Chapter 3, how can a man be born again? How does this affect belief?
- II. **Jesus's death is for all ethnic groups** (vv.49-52).
 - a. How did Caiaphas know Jesus was supposed to die?
 - b. What was Caiaphas' conclusion for the reason Jesus had to die?
 - c. Why did Jesus come to die? Who did Jesus die for according to John 6:37-40?
- III. **Jesus's life is not taken, but given** (vv.53-57).
 - a. How is God's sovereignty displayed in this section of the passage?
 - b. Why is it important that Jesus gave his life, and it is not taken (read John 10:14-18)?
 - c. What does this section show about man's heart and the wisdom of man?
- IV. Application
 - a. Reflect on Proverbs 16:9.
 - b. How are you trusting in the sovereignty of God and his plan to work through your difficulties for his glory? (Discuss this as a group.)
