


Is God the Center of Your Camp?

Study Questions

From our study this week on Numbers 1-9 we saw that God's design is that He would occupy the center of our lives. Read Numbers 1-2 and chapter 9 and answer these questions.



1. What do I rearrange my life for without hesitation? How does this reveal what is at the center of your life?
2. What challenges do you think make it hard for you to keep God and "Kingdom Living" in that place of supreme priority?
3. Can you think of some ways you can pursue making God the center of your life (meaning that all the "spokes" of life would be flowing out of your trust in God and your relationship with Him)? Are there certain areas that are harder to surrender? Why?
4. In what ways can you relate to Israel's wandering in Numbers?
5. How can seasons of waiting actually reveal what we've been centered on?
6. Making God the center of your life is a lifelong pursuit. What is one thing that you can do on a daily basis to begin re-ordering your life to revolve around God as the center of your "Camp"?

7. How does this picture of Jesus and his followers reflect the same idea of the importance of God being in the center of everything in our lives? How are they different?
