Loads of Love: Clean Clothes, Dignity, and Your Impact

It has been an incredible year for Loads of Love, and we are so grateful for the congregation's ongoing support! We are thrilled to announce that we have successfully completed the \$10,000 grant from the Florida Keys Outreach Coalition and Driftwood! This grant has enabled us to offer a crucial service to our most vulnerable neighbors consistently. We've already applied to renew the \$10,000 for next year and should hear in November.

The tangible impact of Loads of Love is evident: Since December 1, 2024, we've held three events every month, serving over 415 families and individuals. In total, we've covered more than 1,061 washer loads and provided 790 hours of dryer time! To ensure we reach those who need us most, we've extended invitations to residents of KOTS (Keys Overnight Temporary Stay) and clients of WestCare, working closely with their guidance counselors.

Expanding Our Outreach We are excited about a new initiative we're developing: a wash, dry, and fold voucher system. Our initial focus for this service will be on new mothers and teenagers, providing them with a bit of extra support and dignity. We are also preparing to utilize this voucher system to help marginalized people during any future times of required isolation.

Thank you all! We are always happy to welcome new volunteers! While we have sufficient funding for our upcoming events on October 6, 13, and 20, our bank account will be depleted afterward. Currently, every dollar donated goes directly towards washers and dryers. We are urgently seeking additional donations to ensure that we can continue hosting events and providing clean clothes and dignity to our neighbors.
